Comprehensive study on the economic value of nuclear power and natural gas to be presented at 2013 ANS Annual Meeting

PROVO, UT – Rob Graber, Blue Castle Holdings (BCH) Senior Vice President for Energy Economics will be presenting an expanded study on new nuclear generation at the American Nuclear Society's (ANS) 2013 Annual Meeting. He will present results from a study completed by EnergyPath Corporation, an owner of BCH; the study was first published in the April 2013 edition of the Nuclear Engineering International (NEI).

The NEI article presented a comprehensive study concluding that while natural gas currently has lower generating costs, there is a significantly higher investment risk in natural gas. Mr. Graber will be expanding upon the concepts expressed in the NEI article and participating on a discussion panel at the ANS Annual Meeting "Next Generation Energy: Prospects and Challenges" in Atlanta Georgia in June.

"Based on the study results, it's our opinion that new nuclear power continues to have significant value in a generation portfolio because of its long term cost stability relative to other generating options. From the inception of the Blue Castle Project, we used and options analysis to support our investment decisions. Six years later those assumptions are playing out as we expected" remarked Mr. Graber
